DETAILED Attnerary



Day 0: Delhi - Shimla

- ▶ Get ready to be departed from Delhi by Evening.
- ▶ Reach Shimla next morning by an overnight Volvo.





Day 1: Shimla To Chitkul/Sangla

- ▶ We will reach Shimla in morning around 8:30 AM.
- ▶ The Spiti Expedition journey starts from here.
- ► Long drive through the scenic beauty of Kinnaur via Narkanda and Rampur.
- ► Travel along the Sutlej river till Karcham.
- Arrive Chitkul/Sangla in the evening and enjoy at the stay for night.





Day 2: Chitkul to Kalpa

- ▶ After Breakfast, spend some time at leisure and check out.
- Chitkul is the last Indian village towards China border. Explore the best of it. Next, you will be departing for Kalpa.
- Reach Kalpa, by evening, check-in to your stay and have dinner.





Day 3: Kalpa to Nako/Tabo

- After Breakfast, spend some time at leisure and check out.
- ▶ Wake up to the Kinner Kailash view.
- ▶ Visit the popular Suicide point.
- Passing by Spiti River, enjoy 360-degree view of the mesmerizing mountains. Reach Nako/Tabo, by evening, check-in to your stay and have local Spiti cuisine.



Day 4: Nako/Tabo to Kaza

- After Breakfast, spend some time at leisure and check out. Head Towards Tabo and spend some peaceful time at the beautiful Tabo Old and New Monastery and know different stories by the Monks.
- After exploring Tabo, head towards the oldest monastery of the valley i.e. Dhankar Monastery.
- ► Time to head toward the beautiful administrative town of Spiti Valley, Kaza.





Day 5: Langza | Hikkim | Komic | Key Monastery

- After Breakfast, spend some time at leisure.
- Head towards Langza i.e. a high-altitude village known for ancient marine fossils. Collect some fossils to take memories of nature home.
- After Langza head towards Hikkim i.e. At 4,400m above sea level. It is known for being the home of the highest post office in the world. You can send postcards to friends and family.
- After Hikkim, visit Komic Village i.e. a destination where you would see how heaven meets earth. It is World's Highest motorable village and situated at a height of 18000 ft above sea level.
- ▶ Visit the spectacular Tibetan Buddhist Key Monastery located on a picturesque hilltop at an altitude of 4,166 meters above the sea level.





Day 6: Kaza | Chicham Bridge | Chandra Taal Lake

- ► After Breakfast, head towards Chicham Bridge i.e. the highest bridge in Asia and allows you to have panoramic views.
- ► Then reach Chandra Taal by evening via Kunzum La and Losar and have one of the best sunsets ever by the moon lake. Followed by an overnight stay.





Day 7: Manali | Depart for Delhi

- After Breakfast at Chandra Taal stay leave for Manali via Atal Tunnel and get transferred to Delhi.
- ► Reach Delhi by early morning on the following day with amazing memories and new friends.





SPECIAL

- Respect the local culture and customs: Spiti Valley is home to diverse cultures and traditions. Be respectful and ask for permission before taking photos of people or their property.
- O Carry warm clothing: Spiti can get very cold, even in summer. Pack warm clothing, including layers and thermal wear. Bring -10°C winter down jacket with you.
- Stay hydrated: Drink plenty of water to avoid altitude sickness. Carry a refillable water bottle.
- Network connectivity: Jio, Airtel and BSNL works the best but if you have VI sim it will stop working on the first day itself.
- O Dry Washroom: In winters due to extreme cold, water becomes a luxury asset so in that case dry washroom is used.
- There can be road closures during the course of the trip, any cost due to that will not be paid by the company.
- Plan for emergencies: Spiti is secluded, so carry basic medical supplies or your ongoing medicines. Our trip captain will also be carrying first aid box and oxygen can.
- On't litter: Dispose of your trash properly and avoid leaving any waste behind.
- O Don't disturb wildlife: Spiti has unique flora and fauna; do not disrupt the local wildlife.
- On't engage in disrespectful behavior: Avoid any actions that may offend the local population or fellow travelers.
- On't expect modern amenities: Spiti is remote, infrastructure is basic and raw in nature, so don't expect the same level of comfort or luxury as in urban areas.



CANCELLATION

Policy

- Free Cancellation up to 60 days before the departure date (Booking amount is non-refundable)
- If you're canceling the trip and opting for a refund within 59 days to 45 days of the Departure Date then only 10% of the total trip cost (calculated aftersubtracting the booking amount) along with the booking amount (nonrefundable) will be charged as a cancellation fee and remaining sum would be refunded.
- If you're canceling the trip and opting for a refund within 44Days to 30 Daysof the Departure Date then only 25% of the total trip cost (calculated aftersubtracting the booking amount) along with the booking amount (nonrefundable) will be charged as a cancellation fee and remaining sum would be refunded.
- If you're canceling the trip and opting for a refund within 29 Days to 15 Daysof the Departure Date then only 50% of the total trip cost (calculated aftersubtracting the booking amount) along with the booking amount (nonrefundable) will be charged as a cancellation fee and remaining sum would be refunded.
- If you're canceling the trip and opting for a refund within 15 Days to 8 Days of the Departure Date then only 75% of the total trip cost (calculated aftersubtracting the booking amount) along with the booking amount (nonrefundable) will be charged as a cancellation fee and remaining sum would be refunded.
- If you're canceling the trip and opting for a refund within 7 Days from the Departure Date then 100% of the total trip cost (calculated after subtracting the booking amount) along with the booking amount (non-refundable) will be charged as a cancellation fee and remaining sum would be refunded. You are not applicable for a refund if you fail to show up on the day of departure under the given timeline that has been provided to you beforehand.



- If you're canceling the trip and opting for a refund within 7 Days from the Departure Date then 100% of the total trip cost (calculated after subtracting the booking amount) along with the booking amount (non-refundable) will be charged as a cancellation fee and remaining sum would be refunded. You are not applicable for a refund if you fail to show up on the day of departure under the given timeline that has been provided to you beforehand.
- There would be no refund provided in case there occur some problems due togovernment orders, harsh weather conditions, protests, landslides, or any other unforeseen circumstances. On the occasion of any such happenings, we have a backup plan ready most of the time and we'll be moving onto that.
- There are times when we would have to cancel some activities mentioned in the itinerary but it's only due to the reason that we would be bound by a circumstance that is not in our control.
- If a trek is called off at the last moment due to a natural calamity/unforeseen circumstances (like rain, snowfall, earthquake, landslides, strike, bandh, etc.) then the participants would be provided with a travel voucher for the same amount that can be used within 365 days of the issuance date for any package worth the same amount.
- If a trek/trip has to be aborted midway due to a natural calamity/unforeseen circumstances (like rain, snowfall, earthquake, landslides, strike, bandh, etc). In that case, no refund would be provided.
- EnLive Trips will not bear any extra expense due to any natural calamity/unforeseen circumstances (like rain, snowfall, earthquake, landslides, strike, bandh, etc).
